This shoot has always been a popular but so popular that in its current format it takes too long to get everyone through (it needed 90 details last year). So it's time for a revamp and this year it's shooting in a team of 2

It is still based around having some fun (always the objective) and the club guns for those that don't have all the required firearms but this year you can (and should) bring your own guns and ammo. Club guns and ammo will be available.

More Details

The following is subject to change but it will be along the following lines:-

Entry Fee

A wrapped gift to the value of £5.00 (no prize no shoot)

Rifles you will need – the club guns will be available but expect them to be subject to a long wait so if you have them then bring your own:-

- 1) Scoped Rifle
- 2) Service Rifle
- 3) Service Rifle with Target Sights OR a Target Rifle of a contemporary design.

Re point 3 you can use something like an L 39 but not a modern target rifle (you won't have time anyway)

You will shoot in a pair with a buddy (If you have no friends then we will allocate one for you!)
Your scores will be for the pair over the three shoots so you will only do well if you both shoot well.

Course of fire

Detail 1

Santa McQueen

One McQueen Castle two targets & two shooters.

Two simultaneous exposures x10.

No more than 10 scoring shots on a target or you lose the top score.

So decide who will take which shots (Left, Right, Top, and Bottom)

Detail 2

2 Shooters over two targets (probably Targets 3 & 4)

Snaps a combination of Figure 11 and Figure 12 targets appearing at random over the two targets frontage.

Each shooter to shoot 5 shots onto the Figure 11 and 5 on the Figure 12.

Yes you can expect them to appear in different places and be mixed up. No more than 10 shots overall on each target.

Detail 3

2 shooters on an Electronic target 10 shots each.

Start loaded (so forget using a single shot) and ALL the shots to be fired in a total of 3 minutes.

So that's the idea. We may change it on the day but be prepared.
